As you're well aware, we must schedule shows and trips in advance, in order to get group rates, reserve space/seating, etc. which requires booking 6-8 weeks or even months ahead. Therefore, we continue to plan and schedule as much as we're able to for the coming months, though it's challenging with many venues remaining closed or unable to commit to dates.

In progress:

• *Florida Studio Theater (FST)* – 2021 renewal subscriptions to residents that we're subscribers this season.

In addition to the Saturday Night Movie, RAC committee suggested a *Wednesday Matinee Movie.* They have access to the FPN channel equipment in ROC's office and has 1-2 people that know how to operate it, so they have volunteered to show a movie on both days. Thank you to the RAC committee for volunteering your time and the Movie Committee for providing the movies.

Two more "social-distancing" activities added:

- 1. *"Guess Who" The Resident Is* contest has been very well received with nothing but positive feedback and high participation.
- Curbside Concerts Weekly every Thursday at GVT and Friday at Plaza Portico at 9:30am – 10:15am (in the mornings before it's too hot). Implemented last week and so far, feedback has been very good and attendance is expected to grow each week as more residents put it on their weekly calendar.

Angie has advised *Anniversary* event be moved to **October** in hopes that we are at phase 3 by then. Pearl had a great idea to do a "*change of seasons*" theme and possibly combine it with Oktoberfest to make it even more fun. I think it's an excellent idea because it gives us a whole lot to work with and the opportunity to go in so many directions. I've started planning the program and budget to present to the STAFF committee (which is comprised of various departments who must be involved in the operations portion of the event....it takes a village).
