Received a total of 44 evaluations regarding Dining Services:

- 23 positive comments with only 1 negative comment about service;
- 11 positive comments and 5 negative comments on food;
- 4 in-between comments on food;

Specific feedback regarding Dining Services:

- Kudos to Pamela and her Front of the House Staff for the excellent Family Style Holiday meals;
- In the Maui Food Pick Up line (while Dining Rooms are temporarily closed) the soup portions are perceived as too small; however, the dining room soup portions are to be 4 to 5 ozs, unlike the 12 oz portions served in the Grille that sell for \$2.10 each;
- Residents appreciate being called by name in the Buffet line;

Menu Chats

Judy Schmidt noted she learned during these informative weekly chats that there must be one steamed vegetable choice on each day's menu. Chef Chris continues to ask that residents submit recipes for favorite dishes.

Theresa Lehman, Dining Services Director:

- Dining Rooms remain closed due to multiple positive COVID test results; may re-open on Sunday, January 9, but in holding pattern on this until Friday. (Friday update: decision is to remain closed until Monday, January 17.)
- 19 openings in Dining staff:
 - 8 servers;
 - 2 supervisors for Front of House;
 - o 2 full-time in the Grille;
 - o 2 part-time in the Grille;
 - 1 sous chef for catering;
 - 1 lead cook for catering;
 - o 3 part-time utility (i.e., dishwashers).

Pamela Evans, Assistant Dining Services Director:

- Continues to work diligently to find additional associates and will meet soon with Lennard High School Admin re potential student applicants;
- Extensive training is paying off as overall service continues to improve.
