

Dining Services Committee Meeting Minutes April 6, 2022, 2:30 PM Club Room

Stan called the meeting to order at 2:35 PM.

A quorum was present.

The minutes from the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Stan Zarinsky:

Received a total of 65 evaluations regarding Dining Services:

- 39 positive comments with only 2 negative comments about service;
- 18 positive comments with 3 negative comments on food; and,
- 3 in-between comments on food;

Specific feedback regarding Dining Services:

• There is a noticeable and steady improvement in the quality of overall dining room service with visible results of training by Pamela and Melly.

Theresa Lehman, Dining Services Director:

- Grille Staffing
 - l employee on extended medical leave; Catherine from Dining Room is filling in;
 - There are NO applicants for open Grille positions;
- Plaza Club
 - o No outside catering events; however, resident events continue;
 - Enchanted Evening planned with Freedom Plaza sister community Regency on April 21.

- Kitchen Staffing
 - o I cook out for awhile; I cook leaving; I experienced cook hired;
 - Down 5 cooks overall;
 - Continue working with HR and social media; i.e., <u>www.indeed.com</u>; etc.
 - Tenured staff continue working 6 days a week;
 - Temp agency cannot find applicants.

Chris Wynn, Executive Chef:

- Mother's and Father's Day menus are in work;
- Also preparing for the Enchanted Evening dinner at the Plaza Club;
- Seder Dinner at Plaza Club on April 15 also in work with lower numbers than expected.

Pamela Evans, Assistant Dining Services Director:

- Of the 9 new servers hired recently, 7 remain;
- 3 servers may leave after high school graduation.
- Kiosks are now available outside the Dining Room and the Grille where a brief 4 question survey facilitates resident feedback on service and food.

Judy Schmidt, Casual Dining Sub-Committee Chair:

- She has received positive feedback on the art work displayed in the Grille by members of the Freedom Plaza Art Club;
- Residents would appreciate being able to purchase pre-cut fresh fruit in the Grille; this suggestion will be tabled due to current staffing challenges.

Innovations

- Anita continues to research the "National Food Day" for possible inclusion in future menus;
- A Cookie of the Month in the dining room began in March with the Caramel Cookie; April is Chocolate Chunk, however, the challenge is being able to purchase a sufficient amount of cookies for the month.
