- *Jeff covered the following issues and told us:
- *A New Ford Edge that was delivered for use by transportation, that our oldest fleet car is now being used for nightly security, and that more automobiles like this are planned for next year.
- *That automobiles used for on-campus driving are really not suitable for slow pickup and delivery of residents and produce many repairs and service calls, so, he is researching types of long carts used in resort areas.
- *He has driven our campus to determine where bush overgrowth causes poor vision and has authorized removal.
- *There is still a constant problem of people walking in driving zones rather than on sidewalks provided, plus people are parking in areas with spaces designated for large commercial vehicles.
- *We should all be observant of our surroundings and report issues on bus trips off campus and anything that could harm our residents.
- *Our Transportation Vehicles are cleaned and sanitized properly; however, it is impossible to keep them completely sanitized at all times.

Discussions on both old and new items followed as presented.

Ron Carter reported on the installation of carbon monoxide alert monitors to be installed in GVT garages. The installations should take place near the middle of August and there are other safety monitors being considered for our campus.
