His plan to have a glass door for it would show the tables, racks, and credenza, which he is currently looking to find in various offices.

*Developing locations to store the bicycles that are currently clogging our Plaza stairwells would improve the accessibility of the bicycles and refreshing the paint lines on the boulevard, crosswalks, and directional arrows would greatly improve the appearance of our outside areas.

Old Business:

Ron Carter reported that the installation of the carbon monoxide alert monitors for placement in GVT garages was being held up until all of the items and back up parts have arrived on campus..

New Business:

*A resident's complaint that Tram Drivers parked their vehicles in the shade while eating their lunch in them caused delays in residents being picked up was debunked. Almost all Tram pick-ups are generated by telephone calls to the front desk and those requests are immediately radioed to the drivers with no delay in wait time. *However, the current use of our Tram being used to deliver in-room dining meals to GVT residents does impact the response time of being picked up and will be discussed when the dining labor shortage has greatly improved.
