

Dining Services Committee Meeting Minutes October 5, 2022, 2:30 PM Club Room

Anita called the meeting to order at 2:30 PM.

Present: Anita Ciota, (Dining Services Committee Chair), Mike Anderson, Phil Bethea, Al Hurlbrink, Janice Kimbro, Carol O'Brien, Jim Price, Eileen Robbins, Judy Schmidt (Dining Services Sub-Committee Chair), Kathy Vore (Secretary), Chris Wynn (Executive Chef), Theresa Lehman (Dining Services Director), and Pamela Evans (Assistant Dining Services Director).

A quorum was present with all members in attendance.

The minutes from the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Chris Wynn, Executive Chef:

- Kitchen Staffing Additions
 - Kern is a Lead Cook who began the day before Hurricane Ian arrived:
 - Frances was a server and is now a cook-in-training while she attends culinary school;
 - E is a former housekeeper who will transition to Server in the Dining Room within the next couple of weeks;
- Plans are for the Thanksgiving menu to published by Friday, October 7.

Theresa Lehman, Dining Services Director:

- Pub Concept Committee
 - Initial 90-minute meeting of the 13 resident member committee is set for Thursday, October 13;
 - o Subsequent meetings every couple of weeks for 1 hour each;
 - Scope includes developing menus exclusive to the Pub;
 - Flooring and furniture have already been ordered due to supply chain considerations;
 - Pub refurbishment is planned for several reasons: input from LCS regarding what is trending in CCRC communities and the reality of using or losing capital expenditure funds committed to this project by LCS;

- Post Ian Report
 - Entire Kitchen and Dining staff did an incredible job throughout Ian with a number of them volunteering to live on campus throughout the storm;
 - Lessons Learned include the realization that at the time of an impending storm, the decision to send food to GVT residents should be made earlier; i.e., (in this instance) Monday morning rather than Wednesday morning which was when the storm's path accelerated;
 - Enchanted Evening set for September 29 was cancelled due to Ian and will be rescheduled;

Pamela Evans, Assistant Dining Services Director:

- Walkers blocking Dining Room exit doors
 - Continue to work on this ongoing challenge; per ADA, staff
 <u>cannot</u> take a resident's walker from the dining room while they
 are having their meal unless the resident agrees;
 - Carol O'Brien of this Committee agreed, as Chair of Administrative Services, to reach out to Carl Bohnenkamp of the Health Committee and they will consult with Pamela to identify a resolution to this issue;
- We have 4 new servers on board;
- A suggestion from a couple of months ago recommended <u>not</u> putting cups and saucers on each table as part of the setup; however, since there is a lack of storage for all <u>500</u> cups and saucers, servers will continue to place them on the tables.

Anita Ciota, Chair:

Received a total of 40 evaluations (34 emails and 6 comment cards) regarding Dining Services with 1 comment on the Grille and 3 about IRD:

- 12 positive comments on the servers;
- 21 excellent/good comments regarding food quality, especially the "great" Spaghetti and Meat; Shrimp and Crab Fettuccine; and, Corned Beef and Cabbage;
- 12 negative comments on the food such as the Tiramisu tasted like stale lemon cake, not Tiramisu;
- Overall, received fewer evaluations this month perhaps because the Dining Room was closed for several days during Hurricane Ian.

Janice Kimbro, Menu Chat Report:

• Weekly Menu Chats with Chef Chris and Theresa offer an opportunity for resident input with feedback about meals and residents also frequently suggest items to have on future menus.

Judy Schmidt, Casual Dining Sub-Committee Chair:

- Saturday remains popular for additional open hours as soon as staffing permits;
- Some residents would like to see a soft serve ice cream machine in the Grille;
- Oatmeal service twice weekly is becoming more popular;
- Can Grits be added to the Menu?

The next meeting is set for the Club Room, Wednesday, November 2, 2022, 2:30 PM.
