

Dining Services Committee Meeting Minutes November 1, 2023, 2:30 PM Club Room

Chair Anita Ciota called the meeting to order at 2:29 PM.

Present: Mike Anderson, Phil Bethea, Al Hurlbrink, Janice Kimbro, Carol O'Brien, Eileen Robbins, Judy Schmidt (Dining Services Sub-Committee Chair), Kathy Vore (Secretary), MaryAnn Wellander, Jaime Simoes, (Executive Chef), Theresa Lehman (Dining Services Director), and Pamela Evans (Assistant Dining Services Director).

A quorum was present.

The minutes from the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Jaime Simoes, Executive Chef:

- Staffing Need one full-time cook; on-boarding of the new Sous Chef is helping fill in; also a couple of temporary workers are leaving as planned;
- Some food tickets are slow out of the kitchen, partly due to residents who come to the Dining Room without reservations and expect to be seated; can be as many as 40 people, often the same residents who fail to make reservations:
- Three dinner rush times are: 4:30 with seating of all 6- and 8-tops; 5:15 and 6 p.m. seatings that include second group of 6- and 8-tops.

Theresa Lehman, Dining Services Director:

- New Dining Program begins in 2024 with the rollout of the Sports Bar on Monday, January 8; Premier Dining Main Dining Room, Thursday, February 1; and, the Maui Buffet, Monday, February 5;
- Menu packet for this new program will be delivered to all residents today, November 1, and includes: Sunday Brunch, Buffet, Sports Bar, Preferred Dining, and a color-coded matrix showing daily availability of food venues from 7:30 AM to 7 PM beginning in early 2024;
- Each menu reflects actual pricing and enables residents to get accustomed to new declining balances being introduced in early 2024;
- Beginning in November, servers will deliver two meal tickets to each

diner:

- o one for the resident to sign and leave at the table and one for the resident's records;
- With the new dining program's ala carte pricing, the signed ticket will indicate the resident received the dinner reflected on the ticket and the declining balance will be appropriately charged.

Janice Kimbro, Menu Chat Report:

- Today's Menu Chat again had good participation;
- Comments included request that servers be more familiar with how menu dishes are prepared, often unable to answer questions about menu items.

<u>Judy Schmidt, Casual Dining Sub-Committee Chair, American</u> Grille:

- Recommended the Grille menu include a date as pricing changes periodically;
- Grille Staff continue to receive positive feedback for their excellent service;
- Theresa reiterated that in order for a dish to be added in the Grille, something has to be removed; i.e., if avocado toast is added, something needs to be removed; can look at cycling menu items from time-to-time;
- Quiche (previously requested addition in the Grille) will be added to the Sunday Buffet menu rotation;
- Yes, the Sports Bar will be a casual venue and therefore will fall under the purview of the Casual Dining Sub-Committee.

Anita Ciota, Chair:

• Received a total of 1,600 survey responses in October; favorability ratings (with "5" being excellent) include: 84% excellent food quality; 85% excellent food variety; 96% excellent server attention; and, 88% excellent enjoyment of their meal.

New Business: RAC Request – Review of Dress Code

- RAC has requested this Committee review the Dress Code, particularly with regard to Residents wearing golfing attire in the Dining Room on Sundays;
- A Sub-Committee of Mike Anderson, Anita Ciota, Al Hurlbrink and Kathy Vore will meet to review the current Dress Code and make a

recommendation first to the Committee, then to RAC.

Next meeting will be Wednesday, *December 13, 2023*, 2:30 PM, Club Room. Note: The change in meeting date is due to several Committee members expected to be on travel the first week of December.
