Jaime Simoes, Executive Chef:

- Staffing the new Executive Sous Chef has been on campus about 10 days and is successfully settling in;
- Two cooks will be leaving this month and Chef is working to identify replacements;
- Ashley is the new Hostess and Dining Check in and is also working effectively.

Pamela Evans, Assistant Dining Services Director:

- Daily dining averages over the past month include:

Judy Schmidt, Casual Dining Sub-Committee Chair, American Grille and Sports Bar:

 - Chef Jaime noted that menu changes cannot be implemented quickly;
- Pamela noted that the General Store currently stocks almond milk; Judy requested skimmed milk and lactate milk also be available.
