

Recommended Dining Room Dress Code

Premier Dining <u>Lunch</u>: Golf Attire (crew neck, polo or collared shirt, golf shorts) is permitted at lunch. Crew Neck: no undergarment or obscene/insulting verbiage.

Premier Dining <u>Dinner</u>: Slacks and Collared Shirts for men and Smart Casual wear for women (neat and stylish, not too formal) is expected at dinner.

Sports Bar & Maui Buffet: Golf Attire (crew neck, polo or collared shirt, golf shorts) is permitted. Crew Neck: no undergarment or obscene/insulting verbiage.

Sunday Brunch: Slacks and Collared Shirts for men and Smart Casual wear for women (neat and stylish, not too formal) is expected at Brunch. However, Residents arriving directly from the golf course who wear Golf Attire to Sunday Brunch (crew neck, polo or collared shirt, golf shorts) should be seated in the **Sports Bar** once they've obtained food from the Buffet.

Cell Phones: Place your cell phone in the silent/vibrate mode with sound off. If you need to make or receive a call, please leave the Dining area.

General: Men are requested to not wear any type of hat in any dining venue.
